

Finals Course Specifications

- To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles.
- Course must include:
 - One combination (including an oxer)
 - Two changes of direction after the first obstacle
 - At least three of the following
 - Bending Line
 - Narrow Jump (5'6"-8')
 - Roll back turn
 - Fence at the end of the ring
 - Long approach to a single jump
- 1/3 of the obstacles must be oxers
- Obstacles to be set at 3'6"
- Obstacles must simulate those found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, hedge, aiken, natural foliage, straw, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, logs, etc.
- Verticals
 - May be built with or without ground lines
 - May be jumped in either direction provided ground lines are correct, i.e. no false ground lines.
- Oxers
 - Maximum width of 4'
 - Ramp Oxers
 - Swedish Oxers (no more than 12" difference high side to low side and no higher than 3'6" in the middle)
 - Square Oxers
 - Maximum of only two rails on the back side of any oxer
- Triple Bars and Hogs Backs
 - Maximum width of 5'
 - Hogs Backs may be jumped in either direction
- Fan Jumps
 - Maximum width of 5' at widest point
- Liverpools, water jumps or water used as decoration are prohibited
