Scanning the microchip and comparing it with what is written on the Measurement Form and in registration assures the identity of the horse being measured. If microchips do not match, or multiple microchips exist, adding this information to the Measurement Form or notes allows USEF to determine the outcome.

- 1.b. It must include the name and email address of the owner and their Federation membership number, if applicable, must be given.
- c. For sections or divisions requiring measurement (Hunter Ponies, Jumper Ponies, Junior Hunters, Welsh Ponies, and Equitation), a microchip must be scanned and identified by the competition steward or official veterinarian prior to measurement. This includes measurements for show purposes only. If multiple microchips are found, or the microchip scanned does not match the one on record with the Federation, this information must be included on the Measurement Form prior to submission. Competition management will be responsible for providing a working microchip scanner.
