Rule Change Intent

With the nomenclature change of the Children’s and Adult Amateur jumpers to Junior and Amateur Jumpers, the reference in cross entry restrictions in JP118.6 was not updated to reflect that it always prohibited the cross-entry in the 1.0m and 1.10m Children/Junior and Adult Amateur/Amateur jumper classes. As the rule requires updating, the consensus is that it should apply to all classes in the section, not just the highest money won class. CSI4*, or CSI5* FEI Grand Prix is struck out on the premise that the other rule change being proposed, USHJA tracking# 003-24 and USEF tracking#? will pass which already inserts language prohibiting those participants from cross-entering into any junior or amateur jumper section, which this committee supports.

JP118 Sections/Classes Restricted to Junior, Amateur or Young Riders

6. Restrictions

- a. Any athlete that competes in an FEI Championship for Seniors (i.e. World Equestrian Games, Olympic Games, Pan-American Games, World Cup Finals) is ineligible to compete in any Junior and/or Amateur Jumper class with the same horse for a period of one year.
- b. Any athlete that competes in a CSI5*, CSI4*, a CSI-W or CSIO is ineligible to compete in a Junior and/or Amateur Jumper class held below 1.40m at that same competition.
- c. Any athlete competing in open jumper classes held at the USEF High Performance Standard or CSI 3*, ~~CSI4*, or CSI5* FEI Grand Prix~~ classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money ~~are is~~ not eligible to compete in the ~~highest money classes~~, in the ~~lowest~~ **1.20/1.25m or lower** height section of Junior and/or Amateur Jumpers, offered at the same competition where more than one height section is offered for Junior and/or Amateur Jumpers.
