JP136 General

18. If a judging error occurs during a class which adversely impacts the results of that class, those results may be corrected by the Judges that officiated that class, provided there is irrefutable proof of the error (to be determined by the Judges), and it is done within 24 hours of the original awards.

If the original Judges are not available, a "R" Jumper Judge, approved by the Sport Committee Chairperson, or their designee, may make the correction after reviewing all the necessary evidence.

All persons affected by the correction must be notified by the Show Organizers within 24 hours of the decision.
