Rule Change Intent

In the Arabian Trail classes, more than one gait may be involved in the execution of a single obstacle. A horse can perform a significant portion of an obstacle correctly and should not receive a "0" score. Currently, horses can be overly penalized for an infraction that is of less or equal magnitude to the 3 and 5 point penalties listed in the rule.

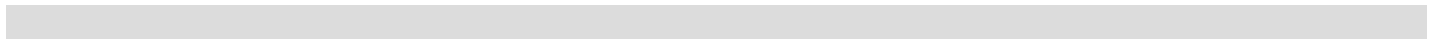
