Committee Actions

HU100 Horse Welfare

- 1. The following acts are prohibited:
 - a. Riding an exhausted horse.
 - b. Lunging a visibly exhausted horse.
 - c. Excessive pressuring of a tired horse.
 - d. Riding or lunging an obviously lame horse.
 - e. Chasing a horse with a whip or other inappropriate use of the whip.
 - Appendages and attachments are prohibited, including but not limited to bags and flags.
 - g. Excessive and/or disruptive crackling of the whip.
 - h. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, aisle, schooling area, competition ring or elsewhere on the competition grounds. The use of a whip must be for a good reason, done at the appropriate time, in the proper place and with appropriate restraint. Excessive whipping will not be tolerated. The use of the whip in a manner deemed to be in anger, on the horse's head, and/or in excess of three consecutive times may be deemed excessive. If a horse's skin is broken due to use of the whip, it shall be deemed excessive. It is prohibited to use the whip following elimination.
