- All horses two and older may be shown in a suitable headstall with throatlatch or a bridle appropriate
 to the discipline they are competing in at the discretion of the handler.
- All horses under two may not be shown in a bridle but must be shown in a suitable headstall with throatlatch.
- A split or single chain lead may be used instead of a rein or in addition to reins; however a lead shank is required if reins are placed over the horse's neck and the handler must hold the shank.
- 4. Gag and twisted bits of any type are prohibited.
- No whips allowed.
