Rule Change Intent

The Junior/Amateur portion of this rule was written prior to changing the names of Children/Adult Jumper classes. Therefore, at that time, the lowest height for Junior/Amateur referred to classes held a minimum of 1.20m. The Jr/Am classes held below 1.20m generally have Zone Specifications that address cross entry restrictions, but this should be clarified in the rule as well.

5. Restrictions...

c. Any athlete competing in open jumper classes held at the USEF High Performance Standard or CSI3*, CSI4*, or CSI5* FEI Grand Prix classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money ~~are not is~~ **ineligible to compete in *any* the highest money class, in the lowest height section of Junior and/or Amateur Jumpers *class held below 1.20m.*** ~~offered at the same competition where more than one height section is offered for Junior and/or Amateur Jumpers.~~

d. At competitions offering multiple height sections of Junior and/or Amateur Jumper classes at 1.20m and above, athletes are ineligible to compete in the class offering the most prize in the lowest height section at the same competition in which they compete in the USEF High Performance Standard or CSI3*, CSI4*, or CSI5* FEI Grand Prix classes offering \$25,000.
