Chester Weber Wins Bronze at 2024 FEI Driving World Championship for Four-in-Hand Horses

Szilvásvárad, Hungary – Chester Weber earned an individual podium finish for the Defender U.S. Driving Team at the 2024 FEI Driving World Championship for Four-in-Hand Horses this week, clinching the bronze medal.

The competition, held at Hungary's State Stud Farm at Szilvásvárad Sept. 4-8, 2024, started out with a bang for Weber (Ocala, Fla.), whose test with his KWPN geldings First Edition, Julius V, Kadora, and Kasper D, earned a score of 31.06. Not only was that score good enough to put Weber into first place, but was a record-setting score for this test.

Defender U.S. Driving Team Completes Outing at the 2024 FEI Driving World Championship for Single Horses

Le Pin au Haras, France – The Defender U.S. Driving Team competed on the sport's biggest stage last week at the 2024 FEI Driving World Championship for Single Horses held at Haras National du Pin in France. The team finished in 10th place overall.

Taylor Bradish (Windsor, S.C.) and Jennifer Matheson's 2009 Welsh Pony Cross mare, Katydid Duchess (Danyloo x Besame) had an outstanding event, finishing in sixth place individually out of 79 starters thanks in large part to an impressive marathon phase where they finished in fourth overall.

Leslie Berndl (Lexington, Ky.) and her 2013 Dutch Warmblood gelding Impressive (First Class x Olizandra) turned in three solid phases to finish in 45th place. Raymond Helmuth (Cambridge, Iowa), and Kendro (Globetrotter x Genderose) his own 2015 Dutch Warmblood stallion, had a strong start but an unfortunate elimination during the marathon phase.

The team was led at this event by Chef d'Equipe Jeff Legg, who saw many positive takeaways from the experience.

Amy Cross (Chestertown, Md.) and Eulenhof Spencer (Arvalon Sion x Carmana's Summer Surprise) earned their first national champion title with three strong phases in the single pony division.

In the pairs division, Katie Whaley (Paris, Ky.) took home her seventh national champion title in the division. She drove her own Timmy, a 2015 Welsh Pony gelding, and Clanfair Sunglow, Gail Riley's 2012 Welsh Pony gelding also known as "Topper," to the win.
