Application for the 2025 USEF Dressage Training Series

Wellington, FL

USEF invites dressage athletes between the ages 12 and 21 to apply for the East Coast segment of the USEF Dressage Training Series. This clinic will take place at the Adequan® Global Dressage Festival in Wellington, FL on January 2-5, 2025.

The clinic is an educational opportunity for youth athletes competing in the FEI levels or currently schooling at the FEI levels (Children, Pony Rider, Junior, and Young Rider). Throughout the week, participants will receive expert instruction on a variety of horsemanship topics in addition to intensive training sessions taught by top U.S. coaches.

Athletes wishing to be considered for this clinic must submit an online application along with one letter of recommendation as well as a video by the deadline noted below. A maximum of 15 combinations may be invited to participate in this clinic.

Applicants will be evaluated for clinic acceptance by the USEF Dressage Coaching staff and base their evaluations on the following criteria:

- Videos submitted. The video must show the athlete riding a complete dressage test at the level they are currently schooling or competing in.
- Information learned about the athlete in their personal essay and from the letter of recommendation.

It is important to note there is no guarantee that a combination will receive membership to the USEF/USDF Emerging Athlete Dressage Program by participating in the clinic.

Application Requirements for Athletes and Horses:

- Children Athletes must be between the age of 12 and 14 by December 31, 2025. Horses/ponies must at least 6 years old or older. Combinations must be schooling or already competing in the FEI Children Tests.
- **Pony Rider** Athletes must be between the age of 12 and 16 by December 31, 2025. Ponies must be 6 years old or older. Combinations must be schooling or already competing in the FEI Pony Rider Tests.
- **Junior** Athletes must be between the age of 14 and 18 by December 31, 2025. Horses must be 6 years old or older. Combinations must be schooling or already competing in the FEI Junior Tests.
- Young Rider Athletes must be between the age of 16 and 21 by December 31, 2025. Horses must be 7 years old or older. Combinations must be schooling or already competing in the FEI Young Rider Test.

Step 1: Submit the Application:

- 1. Sign into your USEF account at www.usef.org
- 2. In your Member Dashboard, select the blue tile labeled 'Athlete Dashboard.'
- 3. Select the blue tile labeled 'Online Applications'
- 4. Leave the Date Range boxes blank.
- 5. In the Title box blank type East
- 6. Select the red Search button.
- 7. Scroll down the page until you find the clinic you are applying for.
- 8. Very Important: Leave the 'Submit App For' box blank unless you are submitting the application on behalf of another athlete and NOT signed into his/her USEF Member Dashboard
- 9. Select the 'Apply' button.
- 10. Follow the steps from here.

Upon submission of your application, an automatic email will be sent confirming the date your application was received. Therefore, please ensure the email listed on the application is current. If you do not receive an acknowledgment of your application, it is your obligation to contact USEF (kbrett@usef.org) to determine if it has been received.

Step 2: The second step of the application is to submit the following to Kristen Brett (<u>kbrett@usef.org</u>) no later than **11:59pm, ET on November 19, 2024:**

- 1. One letter of recommendation from your current trainer, or a trainer who has knowledge of your abilities, describing in detail your experience and capabilities.
- 2. Write a short essay describing your equestrian goals and future plans.
- 3. If you were unable submit your video through the online application portal, the video link must be received no later by kbrett@usef.org by 11:59pm, ET on November 19, 2024.

Applicants will be notified if they have been selected on or around December 2, 2024. Preference may be given to USEF/USDF Emerging Athlete Program Members.
