

US Equestrian Dressage Equipment Review

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this review process is to allow dressage equipment manufacturers to submit their new products or prototypes (bits, bridles, saddles, etc.) for review and determination of compliance with current USEF Dressage Rules.

<u>Process</u>: Proposals/requests must be submitted in writing to the US Equestrian Dressage Department (dressage@usef.org), using the template provided below. Only completed request forms will be forwarded to the US Equestrian Dressage Sport Committee or its Designees (Dressage Rules Working Group) for consideration. These Groups may also request that more information be submitted for thorough review. Samples of the equipment <u>must</u> be submitted with each initial request. Review by committees may take 4-6 months. After review, a final decision will be communicated to the requestors. Review applications may only be submitted one time annually per product. All requests must be submitted to the Dressage Department by October 1st each year.

There is a fee for this process: \$25 for each submission.
