

PRE-COMPETITION BIOSECURITY CHECKLIST FOR COMPETITORS

- Check the EDCC for diseases in the area
- Check show prize list for entry requirements which may include:
 - Health Certificate
 - Owner Health Declaration
 - Flu & EHV Vaccinations
- Make sure your horse has a temperature below 101.5°F and has no signs of illness
- Clean & disinfect trailer and all equipment

PRE-COMPETITION BIOSECURITY CHECKLIST FOR COMPETITION MANAGERS

- Check the EDCC for diseases in the area
- USEF recommends the following entry requirements for healthy horses:
 - Health Certificate
 - Owner Health Declaration
 - Flu & EHV Vaccinations (within last 6 months)
- Ensure entire facility, including stalls, is cleaned and disinfected
- Make sure biosecurity messaging includes signage on the show grounds and an email to competitors

BIOSECURITY CHECKLIST DURING COMPETITION

- Avoid direct horse-to-horse contact
- Monitor your horse for clinical signs of disease and report a temperature over 101.5°F to a veterinarian
- Avoid non-essential people touching horses
- Avoid sharing equipment unless it is thoroughly cleaned & disinfected between uses
- Avoid use of communal water sources

POST-COMPETITION BIOSECURITY CHECKLIST

*Leaving an equine event?
Don't take disease with you!*

- Clean and disinfect equipment
- Properly dispose or return any unused supplies (ex: feed + bedding)
- Isolate horses upon return (ideally 14 days)
