## **FLY SHEETS & FLY MASKS**

Make sure your horse is wearing fly sheets and fly masks with ears and extension over the muzzle. This is a very important barrier between your horse and the flies.



# PROTECT YOUR HORSE: FLY PREVENTION

## FLY SPRAY

A long-acting fly spray that is resistant to rain is key when reducing fly exposure to your horse.



# PROTECT YOUR HORSE: FLY PREVENTION

## FLY OINTMENT

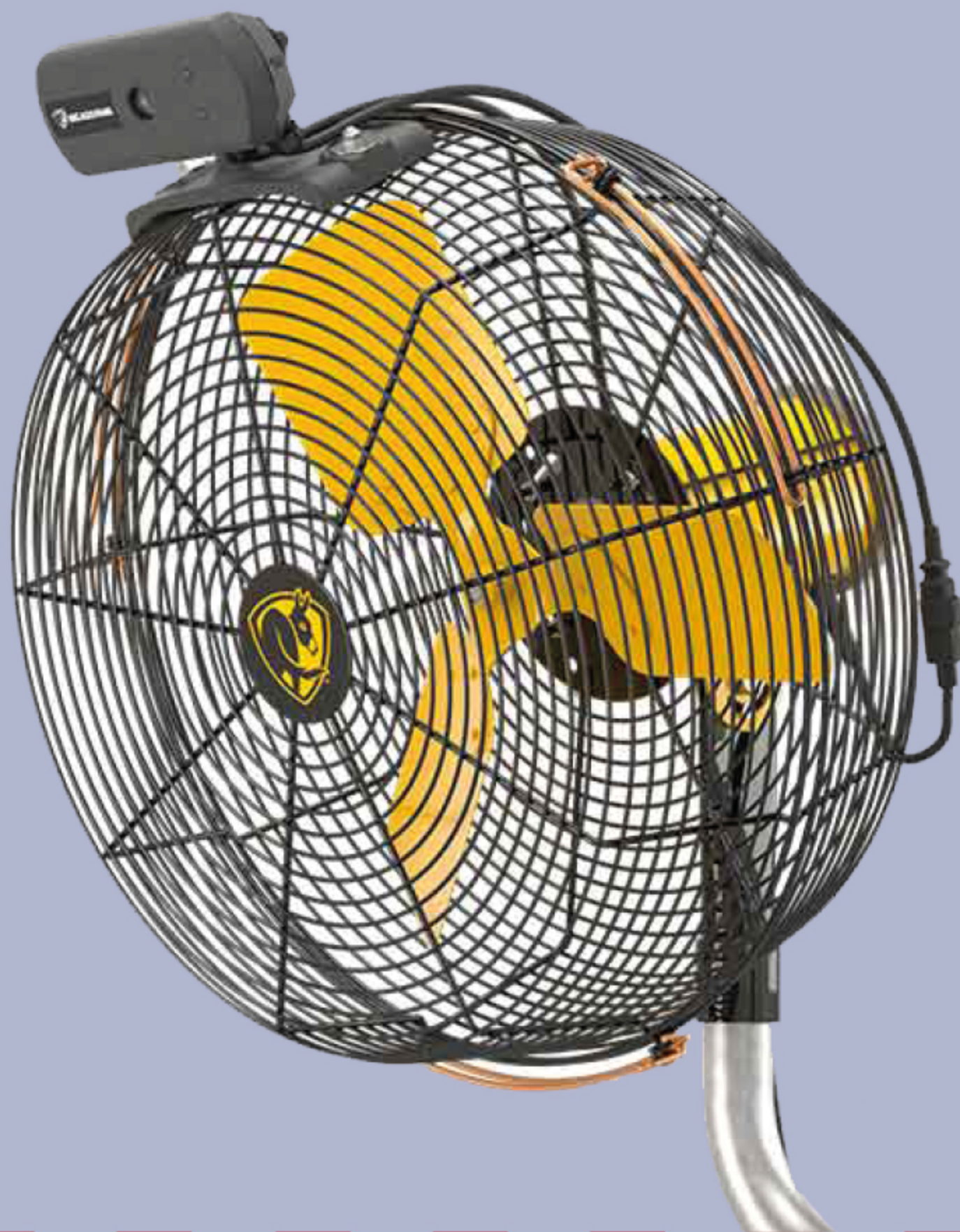
Protect the high risk areas of the horse (muzzle, ears, and around the eyes) with a roll-on or fly ointment.

## **FAN**

**Install a fan on the stall door. Circulating the air in the stall helps deter flies.**
