WHAT IS BULLYING?

Bullying behaviors, under the USEF Safe Sport Policy, are <u>repeated</u> and/or <u>severe</u> behaviors that are aggressive, directed at a minor, and intended or likely to hurt, control, or diminish the minor emotionally, physically, or sexually.

BULLYING

(under the USEF Safe Sport Policy)

- ► HITTING SOMEONE
- > THROWING OBJECTS AT SOMEONE
- ► TAUNTING OR RIDICULING
- ► GOSSIP WITH INTENT TO HURT SOMEONE'S REPUTATION OR EMOTIONS
- ► USING SOCIAL MEDIA TO INTIMIDATE OR HUMILIATE

NOT BULLYING

(under the USEF Safe Sport Policy)

- ► RUDE BEHAVIOR (unless repetitive)
- ► MEAN ACTIONS (unless repetitive)
- **EXPRESSING DIFFERENT OPINIONS**
