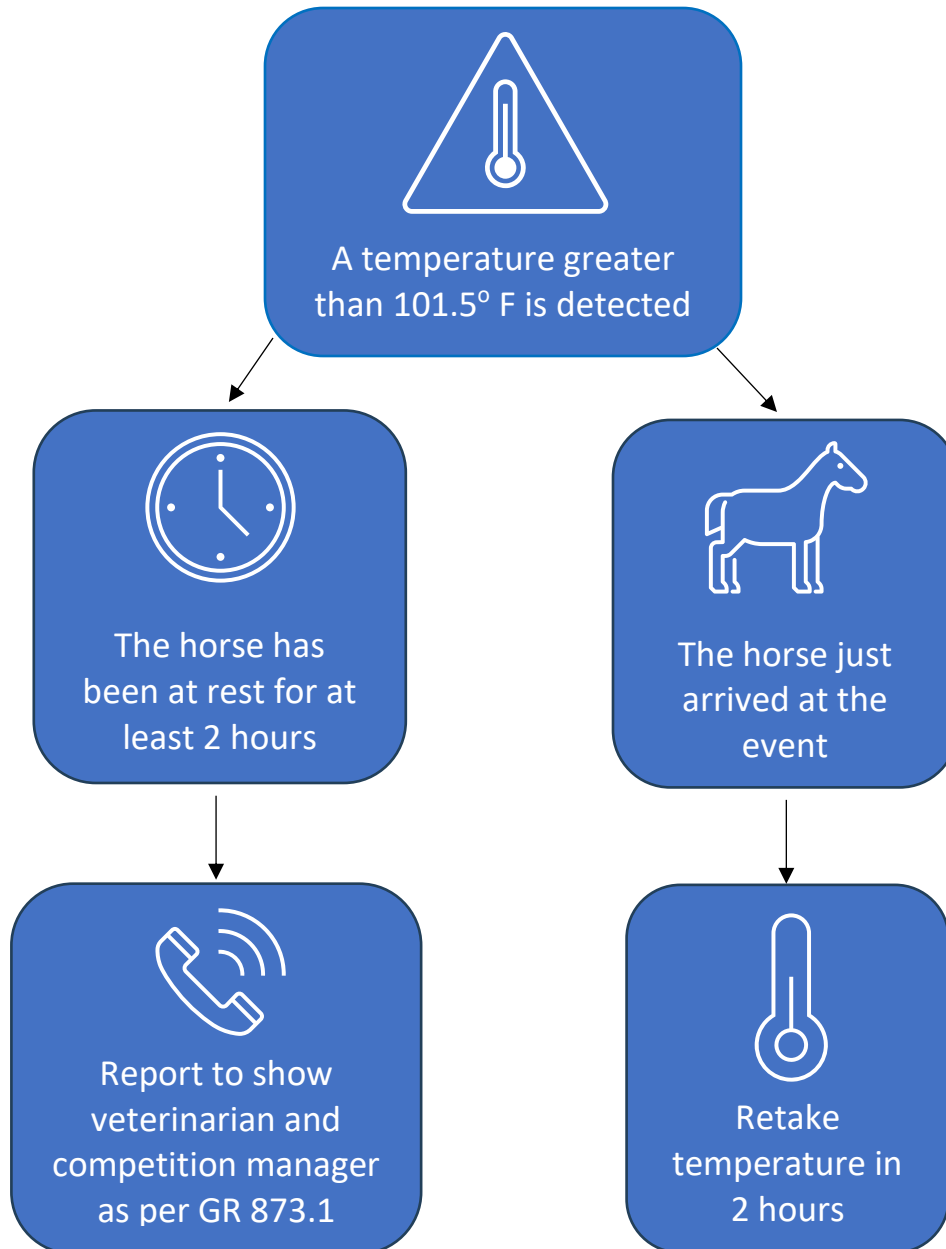




Alert: Mandatory Reporting of a Fever In a Horse at a USEF Competition (Temperature Over 101.5° F)



*Note: GR873.1 states “The trainer, as defined by Federation rules, or the owner if the trainer is unavailable, or the rider if the trainer and owner are both unavailable, shall notify the competition veterinarian and Competition Management as soon as possible but no later than two hours after the detection of any febrile horse or pony. A febrile horse or pony is one with an unexplained temperature above 101.5° F at rest (i.e. two hours after exercise or transport). If a febrile horse or pony is detected outside of competition hours or before the competition begins, notification must occur as soon as possible but no later than one hour after detection of the fever above 101.5° F”.
