Prize Giving Ceremonies:



All First Individual Qualifying Classes (#1, #5, #9, #13) ribbons to 10th place. Top 6 ride for ribbons. All Team Competitions: Team ribbons to 6th place. Top 3 teams ride for ribbons and podium presentation. Must have groom/handler to hold horse in the ring while athlete is on the podium.

All Farewell Class: ribbons to 10th place. Top 6 ride for ribbons

All Individual Finals: ribbons to 10th place. Top 6 ride for ribbons. Top 3 podium presentation. <u>Dressage</u>

4th-8th place on foot (athlete only) are announced and acknowledged.

Bronze, Silver, and Gold athlete/horse combinations enter arena.

All will walk in and line up behind their place at the podiums (grooms and chefs to follow on foot)



Lunch will be provided in the NAYC Riders Lounge for Athletes, Grooms, and Chefs d'Equipe daily from 11:30am – 2:00pm beginning Tuesday, July 30. Riders lounge is available with refreshments daily.

Schooling of Horses - JUMPING

Juniors and Young Riders

FEI Jumping Rules Annex IX Art. 10.1. Under penalty of disqualification, it is not permitted for a Young Rider's or a Junior's Horse to be schooled by anyone else other than the Athlete himself mounted in the saddle, in or outside the venue where an Event or a Championship is held, as from **6:00pm Wednesday, July 31** until the conclusion of the whole Event or Championship. However, lunging, work in hand, etc. by someone other than the Athlete, under the supervision of the stewards, are permitted.

Children and Pre-Juniors

FEI Jumping Rules Annex XII Art. 9.1 - Under penalty of Elimination, it is prohibited for an Athlete's Horse to be schooled by anybody mounted in the saddle, other than the Athlete himself, in or outside the venue where the Event or a Championship is held, as from **6:00pm Tuesday**, **July 30** until the conclusion of the whole Event or Championship. However, lunging, work in hand, etc., by someone other than the Athlete, under the supervision of the FEI stewards, is permitted.

Special Awards Across Dressage and Jumping

Captain Andrew B. de Szinay Memorial Sportsman Trophy


The Captain Andrew B. de Szinay Memorial Sportsman Trophy is given to the athlete across all disciplines who best personifies the high standards and virtues of integrity, sportsmanship, honor, courage, team spirit, good temper and unselfishness. This award is presented annually by the United States Equestrian Federation in honor of Captain Andrew B. de Szinay who was a teacher, dressage judge, technical delegate and long-time supporter of the Young Rider's program. His dedication and support has helped the championships become what it is today.

HorsePower Trophy

Started in 2011, the HorsePower Trophy is given to the horse that stands out from their peers at the FEI North American Junior and Young Rider Championships. This award recognizes an outstanding horse, from any of the championship disciplines, who best demonstrates determination, courage, class, heart and the ability to inspire athletes and spectators alike throughout the competition.

Howard B. Simpson High Five Trophy

The Howard B. Simpson High Five Trophy is awarded annually to the volunteer who best exemplifies Howard's spirit of volunteering. The award honors Howard B. Simpson who served as the NAYRC Director at Tempel Farms for many years. Howard also served as sponsor and tireless volunteer. The recipient of this award embodies Howard's dedication and commitment to the championships. The award is presented by the United States Equestrian Federation.
