

JP111 Tack and Attire

12. Hooded blinkers, sunglasses, fly masks, goggles, etc. that cover the horse's eyes are only allowed with a veterinary certificate stating the necessity. Blinkers or cheek pieces attached to the bridle may not exceed 5cm (2").

The rule does not state that it only applies while in the competition ring and therefore, it applies when riding on the competition grounds. Below are examples of what is **not** permitted per JP 111.12.



The above are only permitted with a veterinary certificate stating the necessity. This is a letter signed by the treating veterinarian stating the necessity of the specific piece of equipment for the specific horse. This letter needs to be presented to the Steward at each competition.
