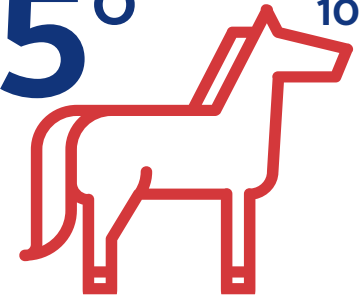

PER GR 873, IT IS MANDATORY TO REPORT FEBRILE HORSES. THE TRAINER, OR OWNER IF TRAINER IS UNAVAILABLE, OR THE RIDER IF THE TRAINER AND OWNER ARE BOTH UNAVAILABLE, SHALL NOTIFY THE COMPETITION VETERINARIAN AND COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BUT NO LATER THAN TWO HOURS AFTER DETECTION OF A FEBRILE HORSE OR PONY. A FEBRILE HORSE IS ONE WITH AN UNEXPLAINED TEMPERATURE ABOVE 101.5 AT REST. IF A FEBRILE HORSE OR PONY DETECTED OUTSIDE OF COMPETITION HOURS OR BEFORE THE COMPETITION STARTS, NOTIFICATION MUST OCCUR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BUT NO LATER THAN ONE HOUR AFTER DETECTION.
