



USEF OVERSUBSCRIPTION POLICY

In the case of an oversubscription, the USEF High Performance Manager, Development Coach and Chair of Selection Committee will oversee the allocation of U.S. entries based on the following objective considerations:

- 1) The athlete/horse combination's trend of overall results.
- 2) The number of competitions that the athlete/horse combination has entered in the previous 12 months at the relevant level.
- 3) Although the performance in all three phases will be taken into account by the above panel, they reserve the right to select an athlete/horse combination with an outstanding talent or record in one of the three phases of the competition.
- 4) Potential to contribute to a medal-winning team in the current or next quadrennial which is measured by trends in results, upward trajectories, and recommendation by the Eventing Coaching staff.

Substitutions for Oversubscribed Events

The panel will provide a ranked order for the applicants. Any withdrawals will be substituted by the next highest ranked individual.

FEI WBFSH WORLD BREEDING EVENTING CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR YOUNG HORSES, LE LION d'ANGERS, (YHWC)

The YHWC will follow the above oversubscription policy. The U.S. is limited to the following number of entries (may be subject to change based on the year):

- a. Six (6) year olds: three (3)
- b. Seven (7) year olds: twelve (12)

In the CH-M-YH-CCI3-L (Seven year olds), one U.S. entry will be reserved for the USEA Holekamp/Turner Grant recipient, provided they meet the Championship Qualification Requirements.*

Applications

The YHWC is an individual Championship and, as such, athlete/horse combinations wishing to be considered must submit their FEI Entry to USEF by the nominated entry date. Applications may be submitted pending achieving the Championship Qualification Requirements, as determined by the FEI each year. Horse/Athlete combinations must achieve the necessary MERs within the Qualification Period established by the FEI.
