



2017 FEI Children's Ranking List (FEI ages)

The FEI Children's Rider and Horse Ranking List are in ranked order by money won. The Children's Ranking List includes riders aged 12-14 by FEI Definition of Children (from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 14). For the 2017 calendar year, this includes riders born on or between January 1, 2003 and December 31, 2005.

Only classes held at USEF Licensed competitions and FEI competitions will be included.

Eligible classes include Grand Prix classes (\$25,000+), Open Jumper classes at 1.20m or above classes, Junior Jumper classes at 1.20m or above classes, and FEI classes held at 1.20m or above.

Money won is 'aged out' over the calendar year meaning that the money won loses its value overtime.

Money won ages out according to the following percentages:

Weeks 1-8: 100%	Weeks 33-36: 40%
Weeks 9-12: 95%	Weeks 37-40: 30%
Weeks 13-16: 90%	Weeks 41-44: 20%
Weeks 17-20: 80%	Weeks 45-48: 10%
Weeks 21-24: 70%	Weeks 49-52: 5%
Weeks 25-28: 60%	Weeks 53/+ : 0
Weeks 29-32: 50%	

The List is published on Saturdays and includes results through *three* weeks prior. For example, the list published Saturday, January 28th includes results through competitions ending on Sunday, January 8th.

It's the rider's responsibility to check results for accuracy. The List is subject to modifications and refinements by USEF from time to time.
