Please be aware of the following application deadlines:

- February 26, 2024 - USEF Early Application Deadline
- March 4, 2024 - USEF Final Application Deadline
- March 10, 2024 - USOPC Registration Deadline - All individuals who have the potential to travel to Paris as an accredited individual must complete the USOPC Registration by this date - this includes athletes, grooms, horse owners, etc. **All individuals must have a valid passport through February 11, 2025.**

***Please apply as soon as possible so the USOPC Registration process can begin.***
