Beginning in the Fall of 2020, there will be one League (no Sub-Leagues) comprised of eight (8) qualifying events. An athlete's best four (4) results will count for qualification. The number of U.S. athletes to qualify will remain unchanged: seven (7) East Coast athletes and three (3) West Coast athletes.

December 20, 2019	Rolex/USEF “Average Ranking List” Date for Phase I Short List Selection <b>Phase I</b> - The 4 highest ranked athletes on the December 20 <sup>th</sup> Rolex/USEF Average Ranking List will be named to the Short List
<b>December 23, 2019</b>	<b>USEF Application Deadline - Phase I</b>
January 15, 2020	FEI Registration Deadline – Horses to be U.S. Owned All horses selected for the Olympic Games <b>must be registered</b> with the FEI as property of owners of U.S. nationality
<b>February 10, 2020</b>	<b>USEF Application Deadline – Phase II Early</b>
<b>February 20, 2020</b>	<b>USEF Application Deadline – Phase II Final</b>
<b>February 25, 2020</b>	<b>USOPC Registration Deadline</b> All individuals who have the potential to travel to Tokyo as an accredited individual <b>must complete USOPC Registration</b> by this date – this includes athletes, grooms, horse owners, etc.
<b>April 3, 2020</b>	<b>Phase II Short List Selection</b> “Horse Ranking List” – The 3 highest ranked athletes on the April 3 <sup>rd</sup> Rolex/USEF “Horse Ranking List”, not already named in Phase 1 Selection
April 20, 2020	By no later than April 20, the Short List of 10 athletes and their horses will be finalized, including: <b>World Cup Final</b> – The highest placed U.S. athlete in the top 10 of the Final Overall Standings at the 2020 World Cup Final in Las Vegas (USA), not already named in Phase I Selection <b>Discretionary Selection</b> – 2 athletes recommended by the Chef d’Equipe in consultation with the Selectors
May – June, 2020	Short List to compete at Designated Observation Events
June 1, 2020	FEI Nominated Entries & Certificates of Capability Up to 9 athletes and 12 horses
<b>June 23, 2020</b>	<b>Selection Finalized &amp; USOPC Entries Submitted</b>
Late July, 2020	Pre-Export Quarantine – 7 Days
<b>August 4-8, 2020</b>	<b>Tokyo Olympic Games - Jumping</b>
