

UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION, INC. HORSE PARTICIPATION CONSENT AGREEMENT (Attachment B)

and end at the conclusion of the Event (Participation Period).

It is understood that the Horse owner(s) must certify, by signing this Agreement, that they have received and read the Event Selection Procedures for the Team; USEF Code of Conduct; USEF Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification; and USEF Safe Sport Policy and agree to be bound by them.

It is further understood that, as required in the FEI General and Veterinary Regulations, (Article 120) USEF's duly appointed Chef d'Equipe, if present, is responsible for the condition, fitness, management of each horse, and for the declaring or "scratching" of any Horse. This does not mitigate or alleviate the responsibilities of the Person Responsible as defined in FEI General Regulations, Article 118.

USEF and the Horse owner(s) understand that under all normal circumstances the Horse will be competed exclusively by ______(Athlete).

USEF does not carry insurance on any horse placed in its custody and cannot be responsible for any accident, lameness, illness, injury, or death that could happen during stabling, training, transportation, or competition. Owner may, of course, and is encouraged to maintain their own insurance coverage.

By signing this Agreement, the Horse owner(s) gives their full permission and consent to USEF and its agents to administer medication to the Horse in the interest of the Horse's welfare and well-being during the Participation Period. All USEF appointed veterinarians will be subject to the FEI Veterinary and Equine Anti-Doping & Controlled Medication Regulations, and any violations of the same may subject the veterinarian(s) to penalty.

Horse owner(s) may designate an individual whom the Horse owner(s) has entrusted and empowered to make non-emergency medical decisions for the Horse (Designee), including the administration of any substances permitted under the FEI Veterinary and Equine Anti-Doping & Controlled Medication Regulations. Such designation must be made prior to arrival at the Event venue. The Athlete will be the default Designee should Horse owner(s) fail to timely designate in writing someone other than Athlete. Designee must be available within the timeframes for administration of substances, and accreditation for the Designee is not guaranteed. Except in emergency situations, no substances will be administered to the Horse(s) without express authorization from the Designee.

All financial and logistical information for the Event will be outlined in the Athlete Memorandum, Instruction, or equivalent, which will be circulated to athletes prior to the Event. USEF assumes no responsibility for salaries or other benefits.

If the opportunity arises for Horse owner(s) to sell the Horse during the Participation Period, Horse owner(s) agrees that the transfer of ownership will not take place until after the expiration of the Participation Period, unless both USEF and the purchaser consent in writing to the transfer of ownership while this Agreement is in effect. Furthermore, Horse will not be shown for sale during the Event.

By signing this Agreement, the undersigned certifies that they are the legal and recorded owner of the Horse and they have the legal authority to bind any and all additional owners of Horse.

I have read and understand this Horse Participation Consent Agreement. By providing my handwritten or electronic signature below, I acknowledge the aforementioned, and agree to be bound by this Horse Participation Consent Agreement and I fully understand and accept my responsibilities as a participant in the Event. I further understand and agree that an electronic signature is a legal and binding signature.
