KEEP IT CLEAN

Prevent fly breeding
by frequent removal
of dropped feed,
organic debris
and manure.



PROTECT YOUR HORSE: PREMISES FLY PREVENTION

KEEP IT DRY

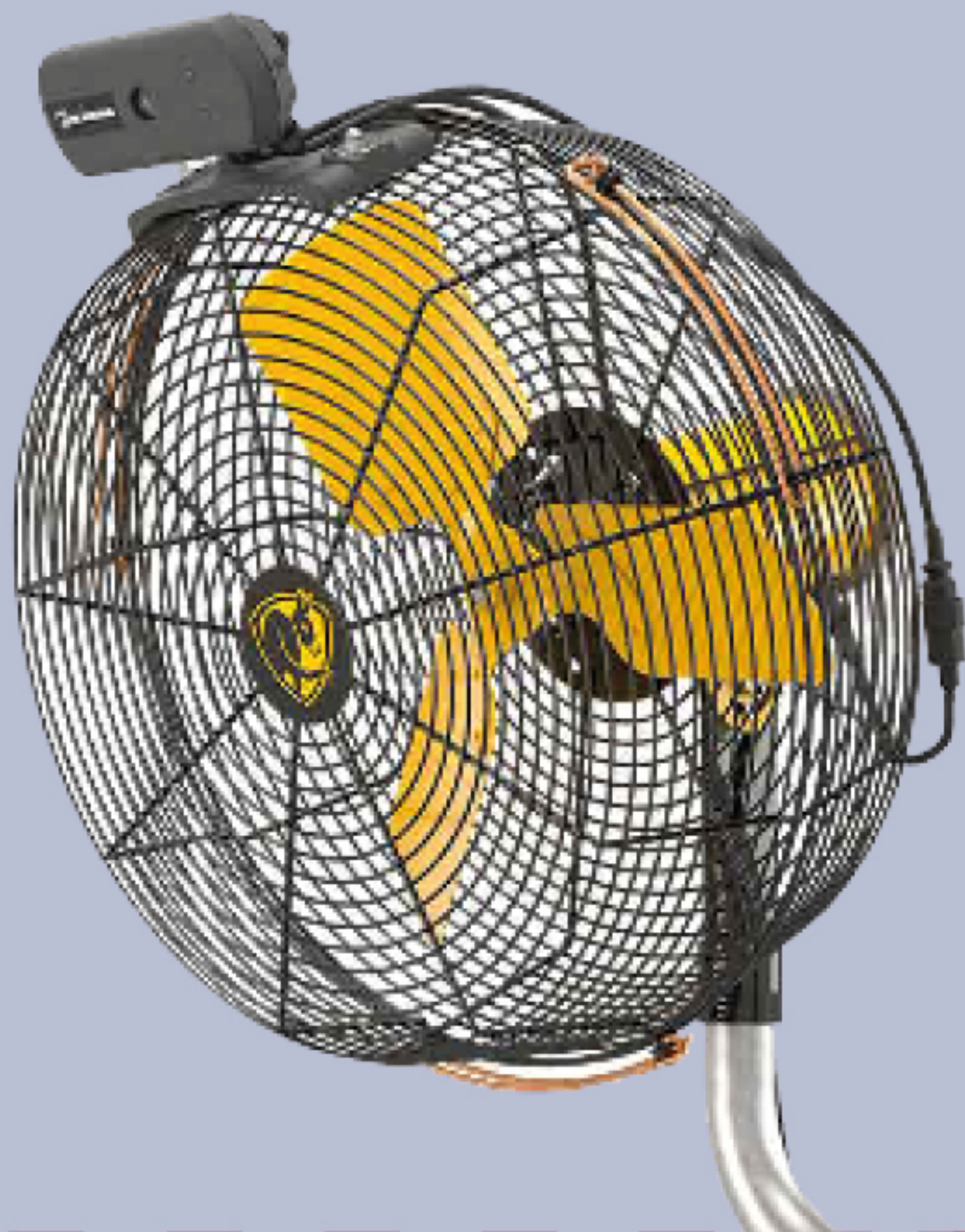
Limit standing water and water accumulation around the barn, especially around water faucets and water troughs to prevent fly breeding.



PROTECT YOUR HORSE: PREMISES FLY PREVENTION

KEEP AIR MOVING

Use fans to keep air moving to inhibit a fly's ability to land on the horse.



PROTECT YOUR HORSE: PREMISES FLY PREVENTION

KEEP REPELLING

Use fly repellent misting systems, fly parasites, and fly traps to reduce the number of flies in the horse stabling area.
