


KEEP IT DRY

Limit standing water and water and water accumulation around the barn, especially around water faucets and water troughs to prevent fly breeding.



KEEP AIR MOVING

Use fans to keep air moving to inhibit a fly's ability to land on the horse.



KEEP REPELLING

Use fly repellent misting systems, fly parasites, and fly traps to reduce the number of flies in the horse stabling area.
