

# VESICULAR STOMATITIS (VS) PROTECT YOUR HORSE: PREMISES FLY PREVENTION

## KEEP IT CLEAN

Prevent fly breeding by frequent removal of dropped feed, organic debris and manure.

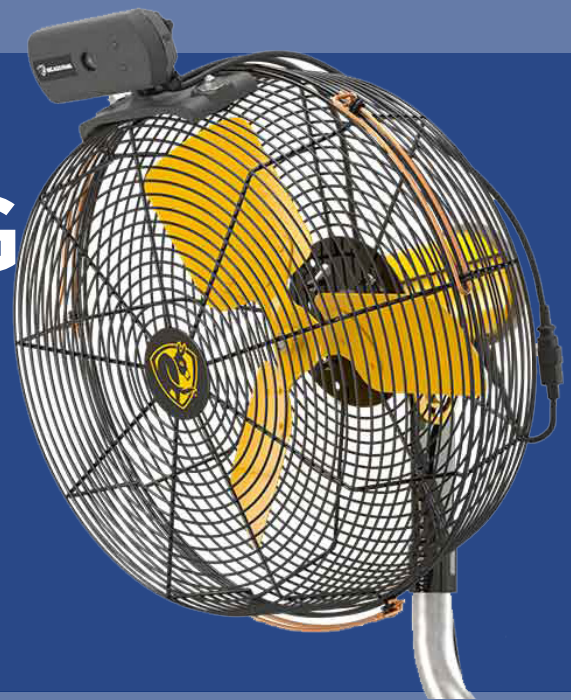


## KEEP IT DRY

Limit standing water and water accumulation around the barn especially around water facets and water troughs to prevent fly breeding.

## KEEP AIR MOVING

Use fans to keep air moving to inhibit fly's ability to land on the horse.



## KEEP REPELLING

Install a fan on the stall door. Circulating the air in the stall helps deter flies.
